Commission Delegated Regulation under Regulation (EU) 2022/2554 on Digital Operational Resilience for the Financial Sector Published in the EU Official Journal (Update 4)

This circular is an update to Circular titled [Regulation \(EU\) 2022/2554 and Amending Directive \(EU\) 2022/2556 on Digital Operational Resilience for the Financial Sector published on the EU Official Journal](#) published by the Authority in January 2023. As detailed by the latter circular, Regulation (EU) 2022/2554 (“the Regulation”) is to be supplemented by, inter alia, a series of Technical Standards and Guidelines.

Following an interinstitutional drafting process by the European Supervisory Authorities (“ESAs”), the following was adopted and has now been published in the EU Official Journal:

1. Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2025/420 of 16 December 2024 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2022/2554 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to regulatory technical standards to specify the criteria for determining the composition of the joint examination team ensuring a balanced participation of staff members from the ESAs and from the relevant competent authorities, their designation, tasks and working arrangements (access [here](#)).
